HCEVB GENERAL CONDITIONS

Players

- Players should always have a respectful attitude toward coaches, teammates, officials, opponents, and parents.
- It is the philosophy of the HCEVB program to develop respect, discipline, and a positive self-image in all athletes. It is important each player understands the concept of being a part of a “TEAM”.
- Playing for a scholarship is unrealistic and places undue stress on the player, parents, & team. Only 1.2% of women play VB at a D1 College some of these are NOT on scholarship, while a total of 5.9% play at any level college.
- Involvement in the HCEVB program may enhance your possibilities of attaining a college scholarship. However, no guarantees are made regarding college scholarships. If you hope to play in college, HCEVB and your coach will assist you as best they can. Goals & Objectives will be discussed.
- Practice and tournament schedules will be provided for the season. Your faith, family, & school work should be your highest priorities, but we request that your commitment to your teammates is also a high priority. We support cross training in other sports and no player will be penalized for missing practices or events for good reason.
- Please arrive at practice early in order to assist in setting up nets and or be warmed up prior to the beginning of practice. Players must also assist in taking down the nets after practice. Each coach may also have their own rules pertaining to their practices.
- Be competitive not disrespectful toward other teams, clubs, parents. Disrespect toward anyone will not be tolerated!
- If a problem arises, we ask the PLAYER first try to settle it with your coach. However, this should never be done during a match. If you’re not satisfied, notify the club director and a joint meeting will be held with your coach, club director, and your parents if necessary. Any discussions regarding playing time will always include the player.
- Players are responsible for taking care of all the volleyball gear, courts, nets, balls, etc.
- HCEVB has a “Zero Tolerance Policy” for under-age drinking and substance abuse at any practice or tournament. Violators of this policy will be immediately dismissed from the Club. This however, will NOT relieve you of any remaining financial obligation.

PARENTS

- Sportsmanship is an important part of all play. We expect good sportsmanship towards everyone and this includes the referees and lines person. HCEVB supports & enforces the USAV Zero Tolerance Policy for Unruly Spectators.
- In the event of player dismissal due a violation of any of our policies (including USAV & Lone Star Region rules &/or policies), there will be no refund due AND any remaining balance due must be paid to HCEVB.
- There are no refunds for any reason and all balances must be paid.
- I will review & execute all required accident waivers prior to my player starting.
- If consuming adult beverages at beach events we would ask you to utilize inconspicuous containers.
